


Cubism

- Cubism invented around 1907 in Paris by Pablo Picasso and Georges Braque.
- First abstract style of modern art.
- Cubist painting ignores the traditions of perspective drawing and shows you many views of a subject at one time.



Cubism continued

- The Cubists introduced collage into painting.
- The Cubists were influenced by art from other cultures, particularly African masks.
